CAPTAIN RICHARD P. BORDONE, USN (RET) (1930-2007) TO BE ENSHRINED IN THE NAVAL AVIATION HALL OF HONOR OF THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF NAVAL AVIATION

In July 2009, the Chief of Naval Operations announced the selection of former EPS Senior Vice President for Telecommunications Worldwide, the late Captain Richard P. Bordone, to be enshrined in the Naval Aviation Hall of Honor of the National Museum of Naval Aviation. The enshrinement is scheduled for May 2010.

Captain Bordone served his country in peacetime and in combat for more than 30 years and retired from the Navy in 1980. After retirement, he served industry as Senior Vice President with EPS Corporation from 1985 until his death in 2007. His illustrious career reflects his commitment to fighting for the freedoms our country stands for today.

Captain Bordone will be enshrined along with Mr. Neil Armstrong, Vice Admiral William P. Lawrence, USN (Ret.) and Lieutenant General Thomas H. Miller, USMC. Past Hall of Honor Honorees include Senator John H. Glenn, Jr. (Col) USMC, Fleet ADM William F. Halsey, USN, and RADM Alan B. Shepard, Jr., USN, among many others.
